BY-LAWS OF THE NALA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY.

PROPOSED BY-LAWS RELATING TO STANDARD CONTROL OF STREET VENDORS, PEDDLERS OR HAWKERS, STANDARD DUMPING AND LITTERING, STANDARD ELECTRICITY SUPPLY, STANDARD INDIGENT SUPPORT, STREET TRADING.

- 1. Notice is hereby given that the Municipality of Nala has proposed to adopt the following Standard By-laws as published by the MEC for Local Government and Housing in the Provincial Gazette as by-law:-
- (a) Standard Control of Street Vendors, Peddlers and Hawkers By-law as published in PN No 179 of 9 December 2011
- (b) Standard Dumping and Littering By-law as published in PN No. 184 of 9 December 2011
- (c) Standard Electricity Supply By-law as published in PN No. 185 of 9 December 2011
- (d) Standard Indigent Support By-law as published in PN No. 193 of 9 December 2011,
- (e) Street Trading By-Law as published in PN No. 205 of 9 December 2011, and
